Performance Certification

UL provides performance verification for Category 5E, 6 and 6A Patch Cords in accordance with ANSI/TIA 568-V.2 with the Performance Certification Program.

Under our **Letter Report** service, UL issues a one-time detailed test report of our findings for the product submitted for testing.

Under our **Performance Certification** program, UL provides a detailed test report and authorizes the ongoing use of the Verification Mark upon successful completion of qualification testing. This program also includes ongoing Follow-Up Service testing, both onsite at the manufacturer and through market surveillance. Participating manufacturers have the ability to show their customers the high level of compliance testing their products undergo with UL.
